

Why I want to Attend Aviation Challenge

I am writing this to illustrate the sample format for the essay for the scholarship to attend Aviation Challenge. First, I will discuss the essay layout. I'll then discuss the components of an essay and finally some thoughts for you to consider.

First the essay format. Please note the following about the essay. The margins are 1 inch on all sides. The text is a font of 12 and "Times New Roman" font is preferred. The essay is limited to 250 words...and yes, we count the words. The essay title "Why I Want to Attend Aviation Challenge" **does NOT count in the official word count**. So, do NOT include the essay title when you are counting the words. Remember, Microsoft word has a feature under the "Tools" menu that counts the words automatically...it will count the essay title though. No reference to your name or family name or title, such as "My Mom, the President of the U.S."

Remember when writing an essay that an essay consists of the following parts: a thesis or essay topic – we've made that easy the subject is "Why I Want to Attend Aviation Challenge". So, next you must start with an introduction, then the body of the essay in which you present your main ideas and then finally the conclusion. Remember from English class the format is summarized as follows...tell them what you are going to tell them (introduction), tell them (the body), and then tell'em what you told'em (the conclusion). Tell us your thoughts – not what you think we want to hear. Before I started this sentence, I was at 240 words and my essay would be disqualified. So, you must be brief in your writing.
