Why I want to Attend Aviation Challenge

I am writing this to illustrate the sample format for the essay for the scholarship to attend Aviation Challenge. First, I will discuss the essay layout. I'll then discuss the components of an essay and finally some thoughts for you to consider.

First the essay format. Please note the following about the essay. The margins are 1 inch on all sides. The text is a font of 12 and "Times New Roman" font is preferred. The essay is limited to 300 words. The essay title "Why I Want to Attend Aviation Challenge" **does NOT count in the official word count**. So, do NOT include the essay title when you are counting the words. Remember, Microsoft word has a feature under the "Tools" menu that counts the words automatically...it will count the essay title though. No reference to your name or family name or title, such as "My Mom, the President of the U.S."

Remember an essay consists of the following parts: essay topic – we've made that easy the subject is "Why I Want to Attend Aviation Challenge". So, next you must start with an introduction (tell us a little about yourself), then the body of the essay in which you present your main ideas of why you want to attend, and then finally the conclusion (what you hope to gain by attending). Tell us your thoughts – not what you think we want to hear. Remember, the deadline for the essay is listed on the webpage and the application.
